

Nick Cannon was born on October 8, 1980, in San Diego, California. In addition to comedy, Cannon became a highly sought-after TV host. From 2009 to 2016, he hosted *America's Got Talent*, one of the most-watched reality competition shows in

the world. His charm, humor, and ability to connect with contestants made him a fan favorite.

Cannon has also hosted other shows, including *The Masked Singer* (2019–present), a popular singing competition where celebrities perform in costumes. His role as host has made him a familiar face to millions of viewers across different age groups.

Behind the scenes, Cannon is a successful producer and businessman. He founded Incredible Entertainment, a company that manages talent, produces TV shows, and develops music. Through this company, Cannon has invested in multiple industries, showing his entrepreneurial mindset.

He hosted *Nick Cannon Mornings* on Power 106, a Los Angeles hip-hop radio station, and launched his own daytime talk show, *Nick Cannon*, in 2021.
